Nominations and applications are invited for the position of Chair of the DAN Department of Management & Organizational Studies (known as DAN Management), Faculty of Social Science, at The University of Western Ontario, effective July 1, 2019. The Chair will be appointed at the Full Professor level with tenure. An appointment as Chair will normally be for a five-year term, renewable.

The ideal candidate will have a PhD in a social science discipline, and show a strong commitment to quality undergraduate and graduate teaching with a strong research record. The preferred candidate is also team-builder, appreciates interdisciplinary research, has excellent communication skills, can be a change agent, and is a decisive leader. Some administrative experience and the willingness to work toward the development of a graduate program would also be asset.

With over 3,000 students enrolled, DAN Management (http://dan.uwo.ca/) is unique to Canada in that it combines a strong foundation in the social sciences with conventional business specializations, including consumer behaviour, finance, accounting, organizational behavior, human resources, commercial aviation, and a new specialization in management and legal studies. The department is located within the Faculty of Social Science, which is experiencing a period of significant faculty renewal having made over 35 hires over the last few years, with approximately 20 more hires anticipated. DAN Management has made four tenure-track hires in 2017-2018 and plans to fill eight more tenure-track faculty positions over the next two years, including three newly-endowed Research Chairs. Since 1878, the Western experience has combined academic excellence with life-long opportunities for intellectual, social, and cultural growth in order to serve our communities.
